- ❖ Holistic Care for Underserved Cancer Patients revolves around Mosabbir Alok Nibash, an 85-bed cancer care home providing comprehensive support with plans for a 250-bed cancer care village requiring resources from various sectors.
- ❖ Mental Wellness of the Cancer Community addresses mental health support through Alokon, funded by corporate CSR initiatives and individual contributions, aiming to create a supportive environment for the entire cancer community in Bangladesh.

Mosabbir Alok Nibash, a noble initiative by BANCAT, is Bangladesh's first-ever holistic cancer care home in Bangladesh. Mosabbir Alok Nibash embodies our unwavering commitment to supporting underserved

cancer patients who travel from remote areas to Dhaka for treatment. It provides free accommodation, meals, nursing care, mental wellness support, and transportation. We are dedicated to empowering cancer warriors through a holistic approach, integrating medical, emotional, and logistical support to enhance their quality of life and reduce cancer-related deaths across the nation.



Mosabbir Alok Nibash Home-01



Mosabbir Alok Nibash Home- 01 was established in 2022 at Basundhara Residential Area, Dhaka. It accommodates 20 beds for underserved cancer patients, a central kitchen, and personalized care, supported by an on-site oncologist, nurse, providing round-the-clock medical care support, ensuring that patients receive care throughout their treatment journey.

Mosabbir Alok Nibash Home-02

Mosabbir Alok Nibash 02 is a modern, six-story facility also located in Basundhara Residential Area, Dhaka. It accommodates up to 65 patients, offering spacious rooms, nutritious meals, and advanced medical care. This expanded facility builds on the foundation of the first care home, continuing to provide holistic care and support to more patients while ensuring access to the highest quality treatment and wellness services.

BANCAT has also placed a strong emphasis on mental health within the cancer community. At a recent gathering, the organization introduced Alok Katha, a new initiative designed to provide emotional and mental support to cancer patients and their families. Alok Katha, which embodies

the Caregiver archetype, creates a platform for sharing inspirational stories and reflection while offering participants a therapeutic outlet through hand embroidery. While Alok Katha currently focuses on embroidered textiles like Nakshi Katha, we plan to expand into a range of handcrafted products in the future. All proceeds from Alok Katha, like selling, will go directly towards the rehabilitation of the patients at Mosabbir Alok Nibash. This initiative enables patients and caregivers to express their emotions and connect through their shared experiences, fostering a sense of community and understanding.

BANCAT has launched Alokon, a dedicated mental health center. Alokon provides emotional and psychological support to cancer patients and their families, especially those from privileged
